ghoulish games, tricks & treats and of course- music & dancing!

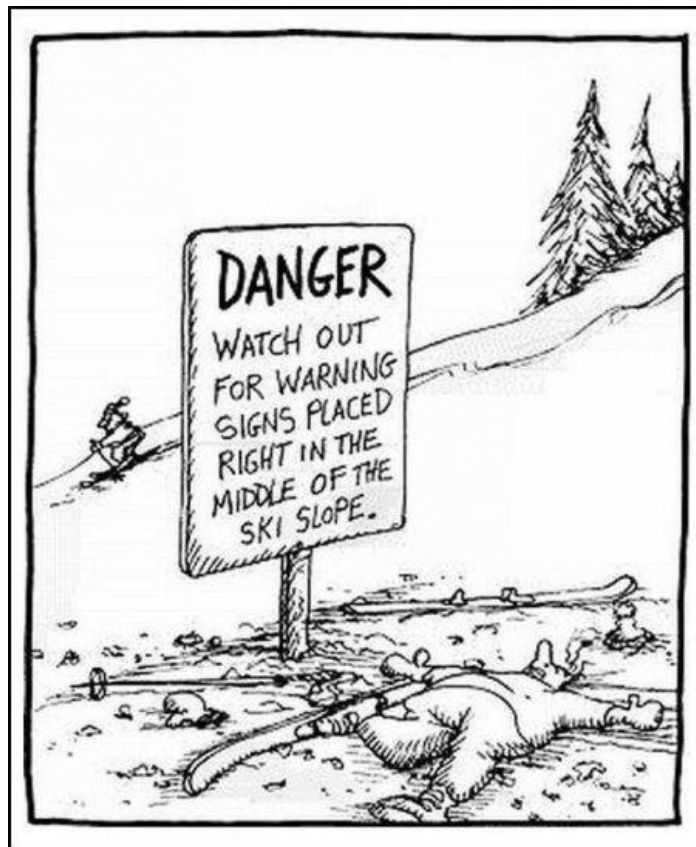
